We are in the process of getting an outside tap installed and getting quotes on having the building wired for our generator. We will also be preparing an Emergency Preparedness flyer to be sent to all residents of the Municipality.

YMCA 2022 Pool & Day Camp

Representatives of the YMCA of Central East Ontario attended the meeting to speak to the YMCA Pool & Day Camp programming that is upcoming in 2022. In 2021 141 children participated in swimming lessons at the pool. 19 hours of family swim time was offered in 2021. 29 hours will be available in 2022. 90 campers attended the programming in 2021. 131 campers have already registered for 2022.
